**Featuring works by Sussex composers including:**

***John Ireland's Downland Suite.*** A classic, moving work from a composer inspired by the South Downs. The suite was especially written for brass instruments but is now often played by full orchestras.

***Eric Coates,*** who was inspired by the view along the Sussex Coast from Selsey when he wrote "Sleepy Lagoon".

***Howard Blake,*** the Sussex-born pianist, conductor and composer, who wrote The Snowman theme.

Together with works from *Vaughan Williams* and *Gustav Holst*, this will be a great musical treat. With over 25 musicians and a wide-ranging programme from overtures to traditional marches; music from film and stage; and the best of modern brass repertoire; this event will suit all tastes.

The Horsham Borough Band is one of the leading brass bands in the South, having been regional finalists and trophy winners, scooping up awards with pieces from high-end classical works to familiar contemporary tunes.

They were formed in 1900 and have been entertaining audiences ever since.

If you only associate brass bands with fetes and carnivals, you will be in for a great surprise!
