

The Royal Holloway Choir

The choir comprises 24 Choral Scholars generously funded by Banco Santander.

Past singers of the College include the international soloists Dame Felicity Lott and Susan Bullock and many others who now sing with ensembles including The Sixteen, The Gabrieli Consort, The Tallis Scholars and Polyphony.

The choir undertakes a busy schedule of services, concerts, tours, recordings and broadcasts.

Following the success of their recordings on the Naxos and Signum labels, the choir now records exclusively for Hyperion Records. Their first Hyperion release features the contemporary Latvian composer Rihards Dubra and November 2010 sees the release of *Time is endless*, featuring the music of Lithuanian composer Vytautas Miškinis.

The choir regularly broadcasts on BBC Radio including Radio 3 Choral Evensong.



The concert at Bignor will feature some wonderful works from famous (and perhaps not so famous) continental composers and will include pieces rarely heard in the UK until now.

It promises to be a very moving evening in the candlelit surroundings of the old church – an event which will be remembered for a long time.
