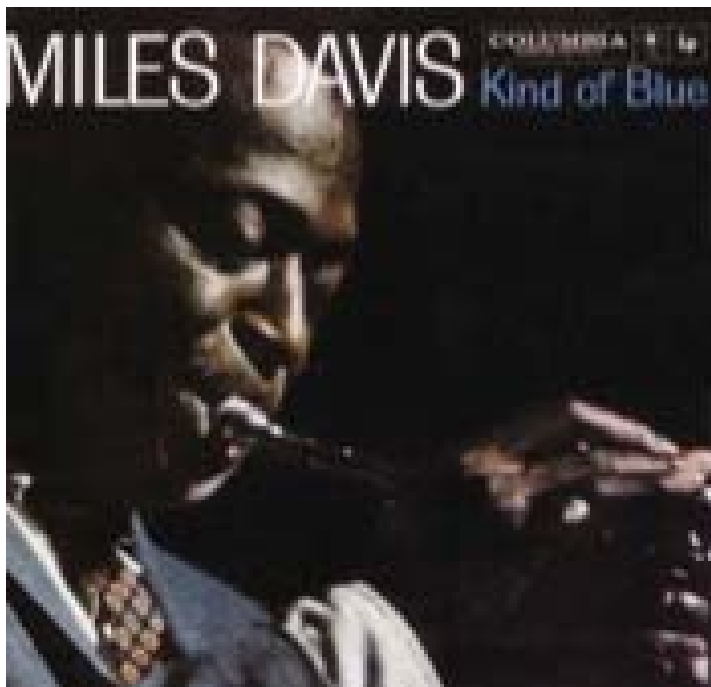


Miles Davis - A Tribute

Milestones is a new jazz group (formed in 2010) to celebrate the music of Miles Davis. The leader pianist Terry Seabrook has assembled a group of 6 musicians to perform the classic top-selling jazz album by Miles (Kind of Blue) which was released Aug 17th 1959. The band has played two sell-out concerts in Brighton and is currently on a UK tour.

In addition to the set performing the 5 tracks from Kind of Blue (So What, Freddie The Freeloader, Blue in Green, All Blues and Flamenco Sketches), Terry has written new arrangements of other songs associated with Miles such as Boplicity, Milestones, Nardis, Seven Steps to Heaven and Prince of Darkness)
