Featuring some of the UK's most talented and respected recorder players, the recorder ensemble **Fontanella** is building a reputation as one of Britain's most innovative groups. The ensemble has appeared in concert all over the UK, and on radio and television networks across Britain and Europe, including festivals in Wells, Brighton, York and in the Skálholt Summer concerts series in Iceland.

Fontanella encompasses all periods of music from medieval through to contemporary. Currently playing as a quartet, Fontanella will feature English music from the Renaissance, Baroque and Contemporary eras, with music by William Byrd, Henry Purcell, Handel, Gordon Jacob and George Shearing.

Their magnificent consort of renaissance instruments showcases the most recent historical research by recorder maker Adrian Brown, for which Fontanella received a generous development grant from the Humphrey Richardson Taylor Trust.

The ensemble has received commissions of fabulous new pieces by Tim Coker, Julian Argüelles, Kate Pearson and Peter McGarr, which have been incorporated into their programmes.
